## Retired Priests' Collection Sunday 4th November 2018

Every year at least £200,000 is  
needed for the support of our  
retired priests. The amounts  
incurred are likely to increase in  
coming years as more priests  
reach retirement age. This  
support ensures that priests do  
not face financial hardship when  
their parish ministry comes to an  
end.

While in active parish ministry,  
priests' accommodation and  
domestic needs are met by the  
parish and a modest personal  
income is usually provided from  
offerings at Christmas, Easter  
and from baptisms, weddings and  
funerals.

There is no charge to the parish  
for pension contributions to fund  
the future needs for their priest.  
The Retired Priests' Fund supplies  
these needs, whether the priest  
is able to live independently or  
whether more care is required.

In recent years, this collection  
has contributed only a fraction of  
the amount needed. Please give  
generously so that we can express  
our concern and gratitude towards  
those who have served us so  
loyally over the years.
