Bishop Richard and Holy Hour for the Dignity of the Human Person

This forthcoming week, the Bishops of England & Wales gather in Leeds for the Autumn Plenary Meeting.

On Wednesday 13th, at 5.30pm, they will gather for a Holy Hour for prayer to promote the dignity of the human person and the culture of life in our countries in the face of the assisted suicide legislation before the UK Parliament.

Our Bishop asks us to arrange Holy Hours in our parishes, thereby facilitating a powerful moment of prayer in our lands promoting the intrinsic dignity of every person. We wish to join our Bishops in prayer. Because our local priests on Clergy In-Service, are away in Godalming, I have arranged an hour of silent prayer and exposition on Monday 11th following mass. There will be silence at 11am on Armistice Day and then the Eucharistic blessing at 11.10am.
